
FOREWORD

In accordance with the provisions of Article 15 of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, stating inter alia that charges for the use of airports in Contracting States shall be published and communicated to ICAO, a number of States have communicated to the Organization their tariff scales relating to landing and take-off and parking and hangar charges at airports in their territories.

The information submitted, which now covers airports in 28 States, has already been of value in the economic studies undertaken by the Organization on the subject of airports and airport charges. In view of the wide coverage of the information, both in terms of countries and airports in different parts of the world, it was considered that it would be of interest to all Contracting States and also to airlines and to others concerned in various ways with the problem of airports and airport charges. It was, therefore, decided to assemble and publish this data in the form of an ICAO Circular. This Circular may be considered as a sequel and supplement to the preliminary Study on "Airport Economics", published in May 1948 as Circular No.3 (AT/1).

Every attempt has been made to check the data given in this Circular, but some of the tariffs listed may be out of date, and mistakes may have been made in the process of expressing some of the more complex charging systems in the somewhat simplified and standardized form suitable for a publication of this nature. Any indication of such errors will be gratefully received, and a revised edition will be published as soon as possible.

It should be emphasized, however, that all types of charge at airports may be the subject of special negotiations between airport and aircraft operators, so that no published statement of tariffs of this nature can indicate all the variations that may occur.

- 3. Aircraft engaged in scheduled services pay the landing and take-off charges in the following manner:
 - (a) The monthly total corresponding to the operations performed on the airport or aerodrome considered as the home or base point of operations of the airline or airlines to which the aircraft belong;
 - (b) Eight per cent of this monthly total, as an additional fee, for each airport or aerodrome used by the airline or airlines, where rates as indicated in Table A are applicable;

- (b) At other airports or aerodromes where aircraft engaged in such services make landings, the said rates are reduced by 50%.

- 3. Whenever an aircraft engaged in its normal service utilizes parking facilities in a continuous and requiar way for more than 30 days, a 50% reduction shall apply for each following parking day.
- Whenever an aircraft remains, for a period of more than 30 consecutive days, not engaged in its normal service, the basic charges indicated in the above tables shall thereafter be doubled; after the completion of the second month the rates shall be trebled, and the charges shall in this form be progressively increased from month to month.
